THE BACKGROUND

In March 2001 the DFHS was invited by Brian Randell to co-sponsor Devon-L an invitation that was accepted on March 28th.

Devon-L was set up in 1997 at Brian Randell's initiative, and in conjunction with the Devon Section of GENUKI (the UK & Ireland Genealogical Information Service) and is hosted by Rootsweb.

Devon-L is an e-mail list for the exchange of information relating to Devon Genealogy and Family History. It has an average membership of over 1,400 people worldwide. Whilst some members are long term, others tend to spend a short time on the list and return at intervals. There is no cost involved except for any ISP or telephone charges.

You will be pleasantly surprised at the amount of knowledge and information that list members have - and you never know, but that elusive answer to a long outstanding question may be just a couple of clicks away

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

There are two ways of actually receiving messages from Devon-L - You can either receive each message as normal e-mail or you can receive them in digest form once or twice a day

To join Devon-L and receive messages as normal e-mail just send an e-mail to

Devon-L-request@rootsweb.com

With the single word "Subscribe" in the message subject and body.

To join Devon-L in digest mode just send an e-mail to

Devon-D-request@rootsweb.com

With the single word "Subscribe" in the message subject and body.

To leave the list and stop receiving messages send to the same addresses with the single word "Unsubscribe" in the message subject and body.

Once you have subscribed you will receive a welcome message from the list administrator and also one from Terry Leaman, the DFHS representative on Devon-L, both giving advice and useful suggestions.
