



THE HALDON BELVEDERE NEEDS YOUR HELP !

HALDON BELVEDERE (Lawrence Castle), Higher Ashton, Haldon.

Beautiful Grade II* listed triangular tower, built in 1788 as a folly. perched high on Haldon Hill. Set in 5 acres of woodland with panoramic views extending over Exeter, coast and moor. Belvedere Tower is open every Sunday and Bank Holiday between 1.30 pm to 5.30 pm from February- October for a nominal charge. The grounds are open all year without charge

When open to the public the Tower is manned by Volunteer Stewards – and we need more volunteers urgently!

If you are free once or twice per year, for 2 hours on a Sunday/Bank Holiday afternoon – then please consider becoming a Haldon Belvedere Steward for Devon Historic Buildings Trust. Steward training on the Tower and the history of the Haldon Belvedere, along with a familiarisation tour will be provided. This is a voluntary position.
